

Work is progressing well on the new Leisure and Learning Hub in Mablethorpe, as these pictures show.







Work began in March on the development of the new 3,000m² centre that will replace the existing Station Sports Centre. The hub will improve leisure and learning opportunities within the area and will provide a swimming pool, gym, fitness centre together with space for digital and face to face learning that will allow residents of all ages to access distance-learning courses.

The new Leisure and Learning Hub is set to make a real difference in the area, and will play an important role in supporting local people's health, wellbeing, and access to learning. We will keep you posted on progress.



Tower Gardens



Heritage Lincolnshire has begun a consultation to get local people's feedback on the priorities and plans to improve Tower Gardens. The consultation began with an event at Tower Gardens on 10th May which saw over 60 people come along to look at the masterplan and visuals of what could be possible. The consultation continues to take place until the end of June, and the images can be viewed in the Pavilion in Tower Gardens and on Skegness Town Council's website.

The vision for Tower Gardens is to reinstate the historic pleasure garden to its former glory through a scheme of hard landscaping and planting. In addition, there will be accessibility improvements to the site.

The planned improvements to Tower Gardens will enhance this historic and much-loved space, making it even more appealing as a place to visit and spend time for both local people and visitors.







Multi-User Trail

The multi-user trail is set to be popular with local people and visitors this summer, making it easier for people to walk, cycle, and enjoy the outdoors around Skegness.

The new one-mile-long next to the A52 between Chapel St Leonards and Ingoldmells, joins up with other footpaths to create a four-mile-long circular route that leads to the beach and promenade.

The trail also allows for links to public transport connections, offering new, safe, and sustainable routes between

resorts and more travel options for local people and visitors.



The trail has been created by Hardy's Farm and benefitted from Towns Fund investment provided for the project. The new trail offers a great opportunity for people to get out and enjoy the area sustainably and actively all year round, helping to support the visitor economy.




Skegness Interchange
