Project Narrative

Skegness

Skegness Foreshore

Officers are presenting a paper to the Council's Executive Board in early September to agree the proposed shortlist of expressions of interests and proposed allocation of Towns Fund resources to the Skegness Foreshore project. There has been regular dialogue with all interested parties since their original submissions to seek to determine the proposed funding model for each development. The information gathered to this point will now form the basis of the shortlisted proposals for agreement by the Council's Executive. The Council has received a utility infrastructure capacity study from WSP which identifies a range of abnormal utility and surface water attenuation costs to be required on each lot to enable future development. A verbal update on progress following the Executive Board consideration will be provided to the Connected Coast Board.

Skegness Interchange (Station)

August brought some good news in the form of the signing of the JCT Design & Build contracts between EMR and Taziker Ltd for the Skegness development.

A delay in the proposed contract programme with start on site now October 2023, although there will be works on site from August 2023 for enabling works, repairs and asbestos removal on the Red Star Building. Phase 1 Main works which will put the Red Star into use; main works start 16 October until 31 October 2024.

EMR are in discussion with NWR around the canopy project and EMR are awaiting final options. EMR have advised that NWR are not willing to give any further funding for the power upgrade, however EMR have confirmed that this will be covered from their contingency fund.

There is no change to the budget. The delay does introduce additional EMR resource costs, but these can be covered by the contingencies in place. Despite this further delay the Contractor has still not uplifted their costs from tender.


Police Training Centre and Hardy's Multi-User Trail

Both projects are completed and have now drawn down the necessary grant required in each case. In the case of the Multi-User Trail there is an underspend of Town Fund Grant of £223,040.

Regular meetings with the two projects are on-going to monitor outputs and potential outcomes to be reported to both the Connected Coast Board and Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities



(DLUHC) via Monitoring and Evaluation reporting (M&E). The aim is to supply DLUHC with all the evidence by the December 2023 M&E reporting time.



FE Campus - TEC Partnership

The project has received the tenders and they are higher than expected. Value engineering is taking place to bring the costs back into the budget envelope. A requirement for a non-material planning application is required once the VE is complete and the architects have provided new plans for submission.

The land ownership has now been purchased. Planning went in to ELDC Thursday 20 July with a turnaround expected within 28 days. Plan to go out to tender on the 25 September, with returns expected 6 November. Start on site 8 January 2024.

One final remaining survey is the archaeological survey, which is due w/c 14 August 2023, once the crop is harvested.

Culture House

The Embassy Theatre and Skegness Pier have been awarded £5m in Cultural Development Funding. The funding will support phase two of the transformation of the Embassy Theatre, building on the improvements that will be delivered through the £1.4m Towns Fund investment.

In addition, and connected to the Embassy Theatre redevelopment, the Cultural Development Funding will accelerate further private investment in the Pier.

Procurement advice is being provided by PSPS Procurement Team; the works will take place in two phases and a contractor is being considered to complete both phases.

Mablethorpe

Campus for Future Living



Lindums are on site and the build is progressing well.

A search for an operator is well underway. An Invitation for Expressions of Interest to operate all or parts of the new Centre for Future Living is now available.

Health Education England have provided £50k extra funding to begin a digital outreach programme. A bid has also been put forward to the Theddlethorpe Nuclear Fund, for funding to look at the development of a creation of small care businesses.

National Trust at Sandilands

National Trust have now submitted their first grant claim now the GFA is signed.

August / September at RIBA stage 4 and due to go out to tender, possibly at the end of this year now. Will not be able to start the landscaping works until this September at the earliest; due to the birds' nesting season.

Leisure and Learning Centre

The Hub will see a new 3,000 sqm centre replacing the existing Station Sports Centre with a swimming pool, gym and other facilities available. The build is progressing well and the programme is on track, with the pool site excavated, concrete poured, wall top on the pool tank to complete, wet area changing floor cast and steel erection well underway.

Recent communications around social value following some good engagement with John Spendluffe School in Alford, including visits to site.

Town Centre Transformation	



The re-costing of the relocation proposal is being checked and a site valuation is in commission. A series of possible additional development options should the current preferred way forward prove undeliverable are also in consideration and the outcome of these discussions will be shared at the next Board meeting. Decision deadline continues to be extended; now September.

The Mobi-Hub will be covered in an agenda item at the meeting.

Colonnade

Working with contractors to finalise arrangements for September start. Darrall Bishop now recruited as Council side project manager to keep everything on track and is attending Design Team meetings with GF Tomlinson. PSPS Procurement supporting contracting side of things – either via an initial letter of intent or early works package ahead of main works package being formally contracted to hit September start for onsite activity.




