	The board received an update from DB  The project is making good progress and the piling is now completed, trenches, cages and ground ring beams are currently being installed. The piling was completed ahead of programme.  The steel frame is in manufacture, and delivery will be around May 2024. On target to complete Spring 2025.  CB asked if there was much feedback from residents around the piling.  DB confirmed that the ground was softer and the piling was easier and straightforward with no feedback received.  DB to ask the contractors to move the Heras fencing to enable access to the bench and bin.  AB confirmed that people were happy with the piling and with the progress so far on the project.  There was a discussion around the delivery route for the building once completed and it was confirmed that there is an access road and ramp to the side of the building however no dedicated access, and there is no provision to provide one, in the current scheme.

Start on site is anticipated around July/August 2024 and works to complete on programme (in updated RIBA report) May 2025.
