6.	Town Deal Programme Update	JB



JBu advised that the programme is in a good place and running towards a March 2026 contracting of all spend. Six projects have now achieved practical completion and proceeded to the operational phase. We are in a good position in terms of understanding the cash flow on the majority of the projects and intending to puruse further dialogue with the projects to help to close individual projects and programme down. TMN will be linking in with the projects to obtain more focussed output forecasts and monitoring closely.

- **TEC Campus** is approaching practical completion and running hard against the programme to achieve a phased opening from September 2025. JB to pick up admission and capacity for the college in AH's absence.
- **The 2 high street transformation** projects have a number of shop front grants completed and there is a pipeline identified against remaining funds.
- **Skegness Foreshore** the Sigma property development is due for practical completion on 28th July, and Travelodge bookings/opening date may be brought forward from the current advertised September date. The bulk of the remaining funding is still tied up with the conversations with Art Council England on the Scarborough Esplanade works, which is still being progressed at risk through the RIBA design phases.
- Skegness Interchange (Railway Station) EMR remain committed to retendering the remaining programme of works and understand that there is no further Town Deal Funding available for this project. JB/SW met with the project lead and they are working towards summer holidays at the latest to have all the phase 1 facilities available and operational. Some delay is linked to a fire strategy which has delayed EMR opening the facility. Local board members were asked to feedback any comments around the station progress, and JB can link in the project lead where necessary
- Seaview Colonnade working towards 24th July being operational (soft opening) and an operational facility. The beach huts will be on site by the target date. The operational elements will be run by the Mablethorpe Town Council (ie tennis court and beach huts). External play equipment has already been installed. The paddling pool is having contractor defects repaired with no additional cost to the council. Recent Press Releases have confirmed that there is now a secured operator for the main season for the Cafe facility and in addition there is a programme of arts and cultural related activities through the councils NPO who will operate from the space. AB confirmed there will be 2 permanent members of security on site.
- Mobi Hub MH has advised the board previously that they are working towards a
 revised delivery position with the project. MH is concluding all legals to enable the
 new way forward which will enable achievement of a quicker timeline, reduced
 costs and lower risk. The funding can be committed within the timeframe of
 March 2026.

	feedback boards. iPads are available and loaded with the surveys for anyone to use	
	and they can enter into the prize draw. Specific work with Skegness Grammar school	
	has received 141 responses. Community groups have also been contacted. The on-line	
	closing date is 4 th August and postal entries by 25 th August. Consultation will continue	
	after this date.
